### **Bishops' Conference Review**

Please pray for the people who will be representing our churches at our Bishops' Conference Review this week which is part of the Accompanied Ministry Development (AMD) programme. Almost a year ago we presented initial ideas of future priorities for our churches to Bishop Chris, Archdeacon Bill and others from Church House. This week we go back to them to review what we've done and to consider what else we would still like to do.

### **Nomination Forms – Churchwardens & PCC**

Nomination Forms for Churchwardens (up to 2 can be elected per church) and PCC members are available at the back of the church. These should be completed and returned to Dom before the Annual Parochial Church Meeting. All current PCC members wishing to continue must complete a nomination form. If you would like further information please speak to Dom. Deanery Synod members do not need to seek re-election as their period of office lasts for three years (until 2020).

#### **Church Opening**

The PCC are intending to have the church open daily for visitors. We are looking for people to be responsible for unlocking and locking the church on the same day every week.
